Letter of recommendation for Ms. Megan Carnaghi

To Whom It May Concern:

Ms. Megan Carnaghi was an intern teacher in my building August 24, 2009 through April 29, 2010. Her intern placement was in a full day kindergarten self-contained classroom composed of 21 students, 10 girls and 11 boys, including special needs students. During her internship, Ms. Carnaghi was responsible for complete planning and execution of lessons in all curricular areas of kindergarten in the classroom of Ms. Tami Teszlewicz.

Our school of 235 kindergarten through fourth grade students is located in a lower to middle socio-economic area of East Lansing, Michigan. It is adjacent to Michigan State University. We serve an extremely culturally diverse population from MSU's university housing complexes, as well as a core residential area. We also serve approximately 35% of students enrolled as Schools of Choice families. Children currently represent approximately 50 countries and 38 languages and dialects other than English. Additionally, we house the Cognitively Impaired Basic Classroom for the East Lansing Public Schools, housing 9 students ranging in age from 5 – 13.

Throughout her internship, Ms. Carnaghi demonstrated excellent organization, management, and curricular expertise in all subject areas. Ms. Carnaghi also demonstrated outstanding development and strength of her level of classroom discipline and student management skill. She has fully participated in all parent-school communication (conferences and report cards), maintaining fine professionalism, while being sensitive to family situations and student needs.

Ms. Carnaghi brought a delightful enthusiasm, as well as an outstanding knowledge base to all of her teaching. She interacted wonderfully with our students, using firmness and fairness in a kind, warm, humorous demeanor. She gained and maintained student respect by the on-going respect she demonstrated for each of them.
